
- Brush and mark trail up Dugs

- Spread P-gravel in rock-climbing area of Gazebo
- Prepare Skull Island for summer: brush and limb removal, tent site improvements
- P-gravel to Tipi sites on Island
- Build sliding doors for Foley Mall
- Repair Hutch skylights
- Change chimney on Hutch woodstove
- Erosion control for Founders walkway by Mom and Dad Kunz rock
- Finish railings on Owl deck
- Seal outside of Lookout
- Firewood; cut and split
- Landscape around Eulie Davis cabin
- Replace front stairs and railings on Lookout
- Paint Buddy-board for waterfront
- Replace log on back of Old Hardwood
- Put siding on freezable storage shed
- New front stairs on Wolverine cabin
